Subject: Implementation of API/web-service for sharing of ePoS level transactional/distribution details with the Central Repository of ePoS Transactions – reg.

Sir/Madam,

As you are aware, this Department has setup Annavitran portal to serve as a dedicated central dashboard/MIS mechanism to portray national level progress of FPS automation and also to monitor the distribution of highly subsidised foodgrains under NFSA in all States/UTs. In respect of distribution, the web-services of Annavitran portal captures only aggregated details of States/UTs and up to the districts level. Whereas, the details beyond the districts level i.e. up to the FPS/ePoS level are maintained in the respective State/UT system/database only.

- 2. It is mentioned that prima facie the details pushed on the Annavitran poral by States/UTs are considered to be ideal by this Department and the same are baselined for all types of reporting to the highest levels. Besides, the subsidy bills/claims and releasing of other central assistances to States/UTs under NFSA by other concerned divisions of this Department are also based on the summary reports/ details appearing on the Annavitran portal. However, at present the central system is lacking a mechanism to cross-check the details on Annavitran portal with those maintained in the States/UTs in case any need arises due to any technical/uploading issues with the portal.
- 3. Therefore, to address this requirement, the Department with technical support of central NIC has setup a central repository of all ePoS transactions, which envisages to collate the ePoS level transactional/distribution details of States/UTs in a separate server through a dedicated API/webservice developed by the central NIC team. A technical document prepared by the central NIC giving the details and procedure to deploy the API/web-service is enclosed herewith.
- 4. All concerned States/UTs are therefore requested to immediately consume/deploy the said API/web-service at their servers in coordination with central NIC team to enable the automatic sharing of requisite details with the Central Repository of ePoS transactions w.e.f. 1st April 2020.
