



Training Programme on Supply Chain Application in Meghalaya and Nagaland

Department of Food and Public Distribution in collaboration with Food and Civil Supplies Department of States of Meghalaya and Nagaland organised a three-day training programme for Departmental officials and godown supervisors/In-charge of both the states in their respective State's capital - **Shillong** and **Dimapur**.

The first series of three-day training programme started in **Shillong** on 18th November, 2019 and concluded on 20th November, 2019. For Nagaland officials the event took place between 20th to 22nd November, 2019 in **Dimapur**. The primary objective of training programme was to train the officials and godown in-charge in operating Supply Chain Management Application, which is an essential component of 'End-to-end computerisation of PDS operation' scheme. The participants were given an overview of the application and live demonstration of their respective modules following which an open discussion session was held to understand from the field level functionaries', key issues and challenges faced during implementation of application and what further changes they would like to see to better suit their needs. After the classroom training sessions, the participants were provided a hands-on training by the Central team to fill any potential gaps between the theory and practice. During the three-days training programme for each state over **550 officials** and **relevant stakeholders** were trained in operations of supply chain application.
