Ensuring foodgrains distribution of PM-GKAY scheme to all NFSA

beneficiaries - reg.

Dear Chief Secretary,

Continuing with the pro-people announcements made by the Hon'ble Prime Minister and successful implementation of 6 phases of additional food security under PMGKAY, the Union Cabinet has approved the extension for the Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana (PMGKAY-Phase VII) for a further period of 3 months i.e. October to December 2022.

- 2. In this regard, it becomes imperative that all the NFSA beneficiaries must regularly receive their complete monthly entitled foodgrains under normal NFSA as well as under PMGKAY, without any difficulty and ambiguities. It is, therefore, essential on part of all States/UTs that tight monitoring of foodgrains distribution is done across the States/UTs. Regular monitoring of foodgrain lifting, and distribution may be done at the top-level and government officers/employees of other departments may also be involved, if necessary, for ensuring effective monitoring and implementation of the PMGKAY scheme.
- 3. It has also been observed that beneficiaries are not properly aware of their NFSA/PMGKAY entitlements, or a sense of confusion is prevailing due to distribution of both schemes in one go in some of the States/UTs. As advised by this Department earlier, it is reiterated that all States/UTs should distribute/issue the PMGKAY foodgrains through separate ePoS transactions along with clearly printed separate ePoS receipts showing the type of foodgrains, irrespective of the distribution cycle/calendar being followed.
- 4. In view of the above, I request you to instruct the State F&CS department to make necessary changes, if required, in ePoS Applications, so that separate transaction, Aadhaar authentication and printing of receipts for NFSA and PM-GKAY distribution can be made. In case of any technical difficulty to comply with above, the concerned nodal officer of State/UT may seek support from central NIC team, under intimation to this Department.
