Subject: Verification of distribution figures under Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana (PM-GKAY) and Atma Nirbhar Bharat (ANB) – reg.

Sir/Madam,

As you are aware that to minimize the food security hardships of the poor and vulnerable across the country, this Department had allocated additional quantity of foodgrains to all States/UTs under the Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana (PM-GKAY) and the Atma Nirbhar Bharat Scheme (ANBS) for free of cost distribution @ 5K per person per month to all NFSA beneficiaries for a period of 3 months (April, May and June) under PM-GKAY and to all migrants/stranded migrant persons for a period of 2 months (May and June) under the ANBS.

2. The Distribution of foodgrains under these two special schemes is being monitored on daily basis at the highest level, and thus a daily report on lifting and distribution is being prepared by this Department basis details obtained from all States/UTs through various channels/mediums and Annavitran portal. Though, utmost care is being taken by this Department in compilation and preparation of the daily reports, but as we are approaching toward the end of June 2020, i.e. validity of the two schemes, it is necessary to finalize the lifting and month-wise distribution figures for both the schemes. In this regard, the reports in respect of PM-GKAY (annex-I) and ANBS (annex-II), as on 26th June 2020 with details upto 25th June 2020 are enclosed herewith.

3. **States/UTs are therefore requested to verify their respective foodgrain lifting and month-wise distribution figures appearing in both the reports.** In case any discrepancy/changes are observed in the data, then updated information may be please be submitted to this Department urgently through email at cpmu.fpd@nic.in and dk.gupta73@gov.in with a copy to the undersigned latest by **2nd July 2020**.

4. In case of no response from State/UT, it will be assumed that the figures/data appearing in the reports are correct and may be finalized by this Department for all purpose i.e. balance adjustment and release, etc.
