Sir,

You are aware that about 16 States/UTs have adopted the NIC-HQ developed Common Application Software (CAS) modules for the implementation of Online Allocation and Supply Chain Management of foodgrains under the scheme on 'End-to-End Computerization of PDS Operations'.

- 2. Presently, these modules are being maintained and managed by the central NIC team on behalf of the respective States/UTs. However, on multiple occasions many of these States/UTs have brought it to the notice of this Department that coordination issues are being faced by their officers with the officers of the central NIC team w.r.t. to the management and administration of these application modules. States will feel more empowered and develop capacity if they manage the application software on their own. It is suggested therefore, that the functional management and administration part of the FEAST application for the online allocation and supply chain management should be handed over to the respective States/UTs. Back-end technical support to the States/UTs for the maintenance of these software applications should be continued.
- 3. NIC-HQ team is, therefore, requested to take necessary steps in this regard latest by 16<sup>th</sup> February 2019 with intimation to this regard. It is further requested that the State NIC team along with departmental officials should be provided training on the management of application.
